The RoadRunners Club is pleased to present the 2012 Proude's Shoes Most Improved RoadRunner award to Rod Gallant!





However, as the season progressed ... it took them longer with each race to catch and pass Rod. And here is why ...

Rod improved his times at all distances. His 10K times went from between 50-53 minutes in 2011 to between 44-47 minutes in 2012. His Clarks Toyota 5 miler improved by 9 minutes.

Rod's 1/2 marathon times improved by 15 minutes dropping from

1:58 to 1:42 He also knocked almost 15 minutes off is Harvest Festival 25K time. It seems to be a trend ... as he also cut 15 minutes off his TOSH Farmers-Helping-Farmers 10 mile Run.





Those more experience runners better prepare themselves, because in a race in the not too distant future ... they are not going to catch and pass Rod!
